Ronnie was the Superintendent of Bexar County Public works for 32 years before retiring to spend time with family and go fishing. He dedicated many years to the San Antonio Stockshow and Rodeo on the Rodeo Contestant Hospitality Committee becoming a Life Member of the San Antonio Stockshow and Rodeo. He supported the youth of agriculture with Helotes 4-H and O'Connor FFA as Board of Director and Swine Superintendent for over 25 years.

As a teenager Ronnie started with his first band Tune Twisters and then went on to form several other bands known as Sideline, Smokey Mountain, San Antonio Combo, San Antonio Country and the San Antonio Dutchmen with his best friends Donald Schmidtenky, Johnny Schultz, Freddy Faulk, and Glenn

Muenchow. He performed all over San Antonio in every dance hall around. He played many weddings, family reunions, festivals, and New Braunfels Wurstfest. Ronnie was the lead guitar and vocals and could play any instrument including the drums. His "groupies" will miss him greatly.

His greatest times were spent in Rockport, Texas with his friends, family, and fishing with his girls. He was known as "Stingray" with his fishing buddies "Keeper Boys" (Justin Adams and Neal Siegler) and his grandson "Shrimp Boy" (Isaiah Schuh). He also enjoyed teaching his Jersey Boy son in law, Neal, all about ranching and how to be a Cowboy.

His friends and family will continue his legacy hosting Ronnie's Annual Sausage Fest at the end of hunting season. He made sure in the last week that his kids knew how to make his famous beans, dried sausage, and BBQ sauce. They spent the weekend at his house cooking while he coached Neal and Cory about smoking meats to perfection and writing down his recipes.
