Rose Marie Limon, 90, of San Antonio, Texas, passed away on April 11, 2026, surrounded by the love of her family.

No matter how heavy life felt, she would lift you up with love, faith, and quiet strength. She also taught us the true meaning of forgiveness—showing us through her actions

how to let go, how to love anyway, and how to choose grace even when it was hard. Even now, we can still feel those prayers surrounding us.

As a special needs teacher, she gave her heart to helping others, showing patience, compassion, and grace to every life she touched. She made people feel valued, understood, and loved—just as she did within her own family.

She taught us how to love without limits, how to stand strong when life gets hard, how to forgive, and how to hold onto our faith even in our darkest moments. Those lessons are now the pieces of her that live on in us. The world feels quieter without her laughter. The days feel heavier without her presence. There is an emptiness in our hearts that words cannot explain—because losing her is not just losing a person... it is losing a piece of who we are.

But even in our grief, we hold onto this truth: her love did not leave us. It lives on in every memory, every lesson, every prayer, and every act of love we share with one another. She is still with us—in the way we care, in the way we love, in the way we keep our family together.

And though we weren't ready to let her go, we find comfort in knowing she is at peace, embraced in the presence of the Lord she loved so deeply.
