Rose Mae Muñoz, 72, of San Antonio, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, August 13, 2020. She was born to Eusebio and Rebecca Ruiz on January 20, 1948. She was one of 7 brothers and sisters.

Rose graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School before obtaining her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Nursing from the University of the Incarnate Word. She began her nursing career at Baptist Hospital and retired from the Audie L. Murphy VA Hospital in 2012.

Rose started her missionary work with Dr. Hernandez and other colleagues in 2008. She provided medical services to Casa Esperanza orphans and locals in the border city of Ciudad Acuna. She worked with 200 patients in a mountain in San Pedro Narangestil, Guerrero Mexico. She went on a mission to an indigenous village in Hidalgo, Mexico which consisted of a population that were only Nahuatl, speaking an ingenious dialect. She was also a missionary in Michoacan, Mexico.

Rose maintained relationships with schoolmates from Rhodes Middle School aka "The Rhodes Group". She was an active parishioner at St. Luke Catholic Church, where she was a member of the Guadalupanos.

Rose loved to travel! She frequently talked about the time she spent in Italy, Spain, Alaska, and most importantly Graceland! Rose loved Elvis!

Rose found joy in attending her grandchildren's sporting events, spending time with her book club friends, hanging out with fellow St. Luke's seniors, meeting with "The Rhodes Group" for lunches, and attending medical

conferences (especially those pertaining to Cancer).

With the busy life she had, she continued to recertify to maintain her nursing certificate, which was very important to her.

Rose is preceded in death by her son, Manuel “Coco” Muñoz and her parents Eusebio and Rebecca Ruiz. Rose is survived by her sons, John Muñoz and his wife, Cassandra, and Michael Muñoz and his wife Lara; grandchildren, Daniel, Carisa, Nathan, A.J., Brianna, and Christopher; her sisters and brothers, Josie and her husband John, Robert, Rebecca, Olga, and David and his wife Arlene; and numerous nieces and nephews.

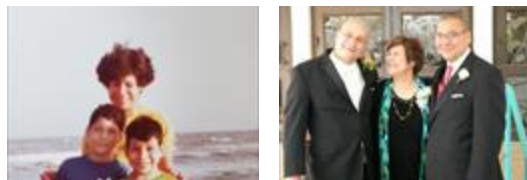
