Rosemary Solis Johnson, lovingly known as “Rosie,” was born on October 20, 1938, in San Antonio, Texas, and entered into the presence of the Lord surrounded by her family on September 17, 2025.

Rosie attended St. Teresa’s Academy before earning her Bachelor’s of Music Education in 1960 from Our Lady of the Lake University. That same year, she began her teaching career with SAISD, later moving to NISD where she joyfully taught for over three decades. She retired after 32 years, leaving behind a legacy of dedication, compassion, and a love for education that inspired countless students.

In July of 1983, Rosie married her “sweet fella,” Dan Johnson. Together, they built a life rooted in faith, family, and service. They served as deacons at Trinity Baptist Church and were active members at both Woodland Church and First Baptist Church. Rosie’s faith was steadfast, and her kindness touched everyone who had the privilege of knowing her.

Beyond her devotion to her family and church, Rosie was a proud San Antonio Spurs fan who cheered faithfully for her beloved “Big 3.” Her joyful spirit and enthusiasm for life were contagious.
