Rosemary D. Radick born in San Antonio, Texas on November 28, 1946; went to be with the Lord on October 27, 2020 at the age of 73. She is preceded in death by her beloved husband Jerry J. Radick.

Rose-Mary was a graduate of Highlands High School and Southwestern University. With her husband Jerry, Rose-Mary founded Underwater View Films and See The Sea, Inc., a nonprofit corporation for education focused on the preservation of marine life, oceans, coastlines, and land-based areas, which have ecological, cultural, or historical value pertaining to the sea. They lived their dream as explorers, producers and lecturers sharing their vast knowledge and "Dare to Dream" motto with as many as 30,000 students, adults and fans of all ages. She believed that education and learning can and should be a challenging and exciting experience and was nominated for recognition in the national program "Environmental Women of Action" for dedication to teaching children and adults positive steps they can take to help our environment.
