



Rowland D. Wolfe, Jr.

June 20, 1915 - November 28, 2007

Rowland Daniel Wolfe Jr. entered the world on June 20, 1915 and peacefully departed surrounded by his family and friends on November 28, 2007. He will now join his loving wife, Edna who went on to prepare for his arrival in February of 1998. He was also preceded in death by both of his parents, Dr. & Mrs. Rowland D. Wolfe, Sr. Rowland is survived by his daughter Suzanne of San Antonio, Texas; his sister Virginia Middleton of Clearwater, Florida; his sister-in-law Alda Bradbury of Salt Lake City, Utah; several nieces and nephews; and four special “grand-dogs”. Rowland attended Punahou School in Honolulu, was in Thomas Jefferson High School’s first graduating class 1932, also attended VMI and West Point. He graduated from Ohio State University’s College of Dentistry in 1943. He served in WWII as a member of the 42nd Rainbow Division and received the Purple Heart. In 1949 Rowland joined the Air Force serving as a dentist for over 20 years. He, his wife and daughter traveled throughout the world Philippines, Turkey, Egypt, Lebanon, Germany, etc. and made many wonderful friends thanks to the Air Force. He retired from the Air Force at Lackland in January 1969. He then taught dental assisting at San Antonio College for several years. He was a member of the American Dental Association, Pi Kappa Alpha & Psi Omega Fraternities, Blue Lodge, Scottish Rite, and Shrine Masonic Bodies, and the Retired Officers Association. He enjoyed golf, bridge, and stamp collecting. The family would like to especially thank Dr. Diaz at the VA, Leslie Butterworth from Vista Care, and Nix Private Care Staff for the loving care they gave to Rowland and family

during the last few months of his life.
