On Monday, August 23rd, 2021 at 8:21 AM, beloved husband and father Roy Garcia passed away at the young age of 49 after a lengthy battle with COVID-19.

Roy Garcia was born on June 25th, 1972 to parents Roy Sr. and Lilia Garcia in San Antonio, Texas. He received his Bachelors of Science in Agriculture at Texas A&M Kingsville in December of 1999; graduating Summa Cum Laude and with the Distinguished Student Award.
