Roy worked for the railroad for a short period of time and then moved to San Antonio to begin working for National Cash Register, where he was employed for over 43 years. He was a hard worker who always acted with integrity.

Elva and Roy Hart married on October 23, 1954 and started their married life in San Antonio. They had two children, Pamela and David. Roy was a loving husband and father – coaching many baseball teams for David and watching Pam’s high-kick routines at Churchill High School football games.

After he retired, Roy and Elva enjoyed traveling together and visiting their children and grandchildren. He was always available when asked to care for his grandchildren, and his influence is evident in their lives as adults today.

Roy and Elva moved to Houston in 2013. Elva died shortly after the move, and Roy stayed near his children in an assisted living community. He was a devoted husband to Elva as she dealt with Alzheimer’s, and a steadfast example to his children and grandchildren of how a husband should love his wife with a Christ-like love.

Roy gave his life to Jesus Christ as a young person and was a faithful

member of Dellview Baptist Church. He volunteered as a money counter for several years and could often be found using his talent of fixing things to help keep the church in good repair.
