Rudolph Cermin, age 75, passed away Thursday, August 18th 2005. A lifelong resident of San Antonio, he was born October 29, 1929. He was preceded in death by his parents, Rudolph and Martha Cermin. Rudy was a longtime member of Crestholme Presbyterian Church where he served as a deacon and elder. He graduated from Hot Wells High School and served in the United States Navy. Rudy was a dedicated employee of the Wayne Bull Company for 38 years, starting as a delivery boy and later becoming the general operations manager for the company. He was a member and served as president of the San Antonio Executive Association. He was also a member of the Automotive Wholesalers of Texas, the Downtown Optimist Club, and the Southside Lions Club. Above all, Rudy was a loving husband, devoted father, and wonderful grandfather. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Betty Scarborough Cermin; daughter, Diane Temple and husband Mark, their children Scott and wife Amy of Pearland, Texas and Stephanie Temple of Brookline, MA; daughter Connie Shepherd and husband Larry and their children Matthew and Benjamin of San Antonio, Texas; Joyce Meyer and husband Mark and their children Sarah, Julianna and Patrick of Corpus Christi; and brother John Cermin of San Antonio.
