July 21, 1920 - October 26, 2015

Russell Demchuk age 95 of San Antonio, Tx .1966 – 2015 and Harrisburg, PA, 1947 – 1966 entered peacefully into Eternal life on Monday, October 26, 2015.

He was born July 21, 1920 in Northampton, Pennsylvania to Lucas and Theodora Zembyk Demchuk. He was preceded in death by his wife, Lois, in 1974.

He was a longtime parishioner of St. Matthew's Catholic Church and was active in the parish's SCOTS Single Catholics Over Thirty Club until 1999. As a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Harrisburg, PA he was a member of the Knights of Columbus, Holy Name Society and The Legion of Mary.

Russ was known for his devotion to God, service to church, love of family, love of country, being a golf and photography enthusiast and a natural musician. He was a Veteran of WWII having served from 1942 – 1946 in the U.S. Army Air Corps. This was followed by a 42 year career in the USAF Civil Service at Olmstead AFB in Middletown PA and Kelly AFB in San Antonio.

In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by his brother, Eugene Demchuk. Russell is survived by his son, James M. Demchuk and his wife Tammy, four grandchildren, six great grandchildren, and his sister, Irene.

Visitation will begin at 12:45 P.M. with the Funeral Mass to follow at 1:30 P.M. at St. Matthew's Catholic Church, 10703 Wurzbach Road.

Private interment for family will follow at Holy Cross Cemetery with Military Honors.
