



## Sallie Roberta Mahan-Offer

August 13, 1917 - January 3, 2015

Roberta Meadows Mahan passed quietly at her home on Saturday, January 3rd of this year at the age of 97. Roberta was born August 13, 1917 at the ancestral home of her father, in Homer, Louisiana to Christopher and Kathleen Meadows. Afterward, her family returned to San Antonio where they had been living. She was a lifelong resident of San Antonio. Two sisters preceded her in death, Mary Frances Meadows formerly of San Antonio and Louise Meadows Janke, formerly of Oklahoma City. She is survived by a brother, Christopher M. Meadows, Jr. and his wife, Barbara Reid-Meadows of Minneapolis and numerous nieces and children. She graduated from Brackenridge High School in 1935 and attended Trinity University, graduating in 1939, and later receiving a Master's Degree in Education in 1948 from Trinity.

She began her lifelong teaching career at Brackenridge in 1936 as a substitute. She then was hired to teach at Sinton High School in South Texas, and taught English there for four years. In 1942, she married George William Mahan, and the couple began teaching together at Harlandale High School. She later taught at Sam Houston High School for 32 years. She was married to Bill Mahan until his death in 1988. Roberta later remarried the day before her 90th birthday in 2007 to August Offer, who she re-met at their 70th high school reunion. They were married for four years until his death at the age of 94.

Roberta is also survived by her two sons of the marriage, Robert William Mahan of San Antonio and Michael & DeAnna Mahan of Austin, as well as six

grandchildren, Ricki & Eddie Johansson of Dallas; Cara Mahan of Austin; Max Mahan of Houston; Joey Mahan of College Station; Rachel & Ragen Stienke of Dallas, and Kristin & Scott Lafferty of Austin. Her eight great-grandchildren include Ava and Escher Johansson; Blair, Drake, Rex, and Rhett Stienke; and Luke and Chloe Lafferty.
