LTC. Sam E. Brian RET Air Force Chaplain passed away on June 4, 2007 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on October 3, 1915 in Desdemona, Texas, to Kleber D. Brian and Elizabeth M. Melton. He served in the Navy, Army and Air Force. A decorated veteran of WWII, Korea and Vietnam, he served tours of duty in the U.S., France, Germany, Japan and Vietnam.
