Samuel M. Ramirez, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, great friend, accountant, artist, musician, and poet among many other talents, entered eternal rest on May 29th, 2012 at the age of 88. Samuel was born in Mexico City, married for 54 years and graduated from the Universidad Nacional Autonoma de Mexico with a degree in accounting. He moved his family to San Antonio, TX in 1965 in order to provide them with a better quality of life. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 7265 at St. Paul's Catholic Church for 33 years. On October 1st, 1986, he joined the ranks of the 4th degree Assembly 1102 and was there for 26 years. He was one of the first male Guadalupanos, helped establish the Apostolado de la Cruz in San Antonio, and was also a member, lector and extraordinary minister at St. Paul's Catholic Church. He was known as a very religious, responsible, dedicated, punctual and spruce man. He was survived by his older sister, Maria de la Luz, his four sons, Samuel, Ricardo, Francisco, and Carlos, his eighteen grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. Viewing will be held at St. Paul's Catholic Church on June 4th, from 6-7pm followed by a Rosary. Funeral services will be held at St. Paul's Catholic Church on June 5th with viewing at 9am followed by Mass at 10am and burial at San Fernando Cemetery II.
