Sandra K. Esquivel was born in Jourdanton, Texas on November 27, 1959, and passed away on April 30, 2023, at the age of 63.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Ben G. and Delia G. Esquivel. Amongst her siblings, Sissy was the

matriarch, providing unwavering inspiration, support, and friendship. Although Sandy did not have children of her own, she cherished and loved each of her nephews, nieces, grandnephews, and grandnieces as if they were her own. To each of them, Tia San imparted life lessons, sage wisdom, and infinite love.

Sandy was the cornerstone of her community. She selflessly gave her time, energy, and devotion to St. Leonard's Catholic Church, where she had been a member of the choir for over 50 years, starting at the age of 9. Sandy was the director of Liturgy and Choir and helped coordinate the church's annual Festivals and Fish Frys. Sandy often brought meals to the San Antonio Fire and Police Departments as a way of giving back to her community. She was also a donor and volunteer for the National Kidney Foundation. Sandy had a special interest in dementia and Alzheimer's disease and was actively involved in helping the geriatrics community of San Antonio. She spent her life putting others before herself.

She inspired us with her voice, always singing and creating music, which was one of her most cherished passions. Sandy's passing has left a void in our community, but her voice still resonates within us, and we will continue to sing along with her.

Visitation will be held on Saturday, May 20, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. at St. Leonard's Catholic Church, followed by a rosary at 10:30 a.m. and the mass at 11:00 a.m.

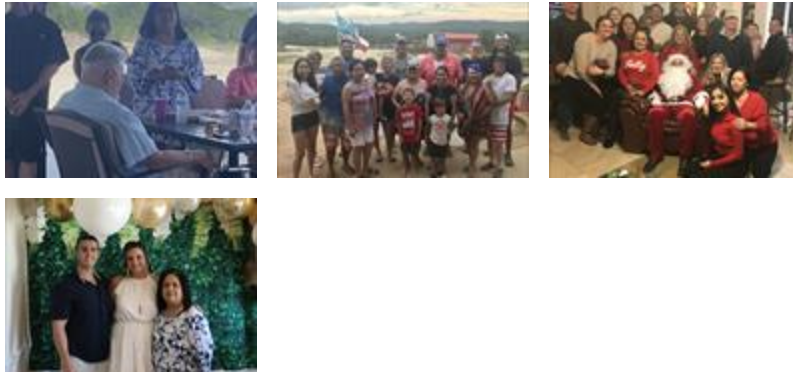
