



Sara Bell Gunter

August 30, 1938 - November 20, 2005

Sara Bell Llewellyn Gunter, 67, died November 20, 2005 in a San Antonio hospital following a long illness. Sara was born August 30, 1938 at Fort Sam Houston, TX to career US Army Air Corps officer Lt Col. John M. Llewellyn and wife Wanda L. Wales. As a military child at the end of WWII, Sara lived with her parents in Florida, Alabama, England, Colorado, and France. Mrs. Gunter's talents in the arts were established while she was very young. In England, Sara was accepted as a student at the Sadler's Wells Ballet School, affiliated with the Royal Opera House - Covent Garden, London. In France she was invited to attend the Barbizon Art School, near Fontainebleau. Sara continued to paint, sketch, and draw throughout her life. In the mid-sixties Sara met and married US Army Cpt. Terry A. Gunter deceased. Together they lived in Alabama and New Jersey prior to Cpt. Gunter's honorable discharge from service following the Vietnam War; whereupon they lived together with their two new children in Harker Heights, Round Rock, and Garland, TX. Mrs. Gunter is survived by her twin sons Eric and Jason, her sister Patricia, a niece, two nephews, and two great-nephews. Her family is proud to remember her as one of the most loving, caring, and giving people in their lives.
