Seferino Hernandez, born on August 26, 1932 in Mercedes, Texas, passed away on January 9, 2007. He was a resident of San Antonio, Texas for nearly 51 years. Mr. Hernandez graduated in 1955 with a BBA Degree from the University of Texas-Pan American and a MPA Degree from The University of Texas in Austin in 1956. He became a Certified Public Accountant while associated with a local CPA firm before he successfully opened his own accounting firm. Before retiring from private practice in 1981, he was a member of the AICAA and TSCPA. Mr. Hernandez was one of ten founders of the National Hispanic Association of C.P.A.'s in 1972. He was a member of various civic organizations, in particular, Los Sembradores De Amistad since 1968. In 1981, he and his children started a successful office supply company, H & H Office Products Warehouse, known today as Today's Office Centre. He and the family just celebrated the 25th Anniversary of the company. Mr. Hernandez is survived by his beloved wife of 53 years, Adela Lala Hernandez; two sons, Joey Hernandez and his wife, Diana and Roland R. Hernandez and his wife, DeEtt; one daughter, Leticia H. Gomez and her husband, John; eight grandchildren and one great grandson; two brothers, Cristoval and Guadalupe Hernandez and their wives and one sister, Victoria H. Hinojosa.
