Sheila May Davis was born April 14th, 1924 in London England, where her Father Frederick Quanborough was studying under the doctor who later delivered the young Princess Elizabeth, who became the Queen of England. Sheila was delivered by the same doctor some two years before. Her father grew up in India in a family made up of doctors. He met her mother, Betty, while returning home to Derbyshire. Alongside Sheila, they had one other daughter, Margaret.

Sheila grew up in Derbyshire, England and lived in a home that was always open as a doctor's surgery. She grew to love Derbyshire so much and lived there on and off for much of her life. She later married John Davis, whom she met at a conservative club where she was working and he was a guest speaker. They were married for 50 years before he passed away on December 14th, 2000.

Sheila had two children, Patrick and Dennis, both born to her in Youghal Eire. Dennis became a minister and moved to San Antonio, Texas, where Sheila later moved after the death of John. Although extremely shy, Sheila would contact so many members of the church continually to learn of their welfare.

Having survived being a teenager in the Second World War in England, Sheila was always very conservative and deeply organized. She kept these qualities her whole life and cared so much not to be a bother to others. She was a woman of great dignity and repose, a faithful caring wife and a tremendous mother to her two sons.
