She was born Sherri Lynn Kerry in San Antonio, Texas on May 24, 1965 and spent her life living in the area. She graduated from Robert E. time vocation. She worked briefly during her illness to help pay her mounting medical expenses. In 1986, she married the love of her life, Ernest Gonzales.
