Sidney Mitchell Sr, age 87 of San Antonio, Texas passed away on Wednesday, July 17, 2019.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Rita Mitchell, and son, Sidney Mitchell Jr.

Sidney belonged to St Ann's Catholic Church and was a member of the Knights of Columbus. He also helped serving as an usher.

Sidney joined the San Antonio Police Department in 1953 and retired with 33 years of service in 1986. He also served faithfully in the U.S. Army reserves for 32 years, retiring as Lt. Colonel.
