Beloved and loving sister, aunt, grand-aunt, Silvia E. Flores, M.D. was a San Antonian born and raised. Born on Dec. 24, 1938, she was always our Christmas gift. Never one to accept gifts without thought to returning the favor, she herself was a generous giver. All her life she gave everyone the gift of herself, and was happy being the life of a party. She attended Tech High School, then the University of Texas at Austin, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Bacteriology. To medical school she applied and was denied. In the 60's few women or minorities were accepted. Not to be deterred nor denied her dream and lifelong ambition, she then applied and passed the examination for the Universidad de Nuevo Leon in Monterrey, Mexico. She graduated with a medical degree from there, and after an imposed service of a year in the country, she returned to the U.S. to take the ECFMG, the medical exam for foreign students, passed, and continued on to her internship and residency in New Haven, CT, where she lived and practiced medicine for thirty years. She retired and returned to Texas where she was a physician at a nursing home in Brenham, TX. After seven years she retired to San Antonio and spent her late years in San Antonio with her beloved family. Although she received her degree in obstetrics, she then specialized in pulmonary medicine, addictions, and geriatric medicine.

Our loss is a great one for she brought light, love, and laughter to everyone she knew.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Juan Pablo Flores and Maria C.

Gonzalez Flores, and her brother, Roland Flores. She is survived by her brother Paul H. Flores of Upstate New York and his wife Patricia, and her sister, Leticia L. Flores Villanueva, her husband Ray Gil Villanueva, of San Antonio, Texas, and numerous nephews, nieces, grandnephews/nieces and great grand nephews, all loved and cherished by Silvia.
