She was facing east to meet the rising sun which shone down shortly thereafter. The waning gibbous moon behind her in the west then bid her farewell on earth. She was truly an angel.

She was born Sonia Fares Haddad on August 10th 1932, the first born to Fares and Mary Haddad in Jaffa Palestine. The family quickly grew in size until her father passed away suddenly when she was just a young girl. Shortly thereafter, she was placed in a convent with her brothers and sister in Jerusalem due to escalating conflict and when war broke out her mother and uncle fled to Damascus Syria, unable to pick up the children on the way. Many months later the family was able to reunite and settle in Damascus.

In Damascus, Sonia met a fellow Palestinian, Kamel Nassar. They fell in love, got married and started a family. Kamel's job took him to other countries for long periods of time so the family was started and raised partially away from Syria until Sonia returned to Damascus and raised her young children with help from her beloved mother and uncle.

If cleanliness is holiness than Sonia is a saint. She had the cleanest, most immaculate house in all of Damascus and a sense of style to match. Five star hotels couldn't compete and her cooking was and is legendary. She was the yin to the yang of Kamel offering her children more freedom and liberalism than was common in the day. The balance was perfect and a beautiful family

was formed.

As the children flew the nest, more time was spent traveling. In addition to living in Amman Jordan, Lagos Nigeria and Baghdad Iraq, she visited many other countries in the Middle East and Europe before moving to San Antonio with Kamel to be closer to their children.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 55 years, Kamel N. Nassar, father Fares, mother Mary, brothers Peter, Tony, George and Ramon as well as sister Frida.

She is survived by son Raja (Hiam Joude) and grandchildren Sandra and Kamel, daughter Hend (Fouad Khoury) and grandsons Shadi, Samer and Rami, son Ghassan and grandsons Ramsey and Jad and their mother Randa and daughter Hanan (Matt Wealthy). Also many nieces and nephews.

She was known for the afore mentioned devotion to family, style and high standards of living but also her beauty and appreciation for the finer things in life. She loved her family and children more than anything else.
