Sr. Chief PO James E. Walker U.S. Navy ret. passed away May 30, 2006 in San Antonio, TX at the age of 80. He was born on October 31, 1925 in Waynesboro, MS to Henry and Lillie Mae Walker who preceded him in death. He

joined the U.S. Navy in 1943 and served as an aircraft mechanic in Pensacola, FL. He married Janell Edmond Walker on April 5, 1945 in Mobile, AL. James flew many missions in Vietnam picking up the wounded and delivering precious cargo. After his retirement from the Navy he worked in civil service at Brookley AFB in Mobile until 1965 when he was transferred to Kelly AFB where he retired from personnel management after 43 years of service. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Master mason of Grand

Lodge of MS, AF & AM, Ellisville Lodge #161, member of the NRA and the Fleet Reserve Association. The family would like to acknowledge Dr. J. Marvin Smith, Rev.
