Stanley T. Zielinski, D.D.S. of San Antonio, Texas completed his earthly journey on Sunday, September 23, 2012. He was born on March 21, 1931 in Houston, Texas. He spent his early years in Pelly now Baytown, Texas. He graduated from Robert E. Lee High School in 1949 and enlisted in the U.S. Army. He was trained and served as a Cryptanalyst during the Korean Conflict. He was Honorably Discharged in December 1952. He attended Lee Junior College in Baytown until 1954 transferring to the University of Texas in Austin. Upon graduation, he attended The University of Texas Dental Branch in Houston, Texas, graduating in 1960. He remained in the private practice of dentistry until his retirement in 2003. His patients became good friends. In fact, the first patient he saw in 1960 was also the last patient seen in 2003. He met his future wife, Jane Davis, during his time at Lee Junior College. They were married for 56 years. He is survived by his wife, Jane Zielinski, daughter Susan Correa and husband Larry and daughters Lauren Christine and Lindsey Nicole; son Stanley T. Zielinski, Jr. and wife Amy and children Victoria, Justin, Christine and Adam; sister Sallye Yrles and family; and numerous cousins, nieces and nephews. He was known as Pepaw by his grandchildren. He enjoyed all the times spent with them.

Those memories will always be with them. He and his wife relocated to San

Antonio in 2010. Dr. Z, as he was known by his patients, will be missed by all.
