Stuart A. Bergman, born in Junction, Texas on January 19, 1914, entered the Kingdom of Heaven to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on March 16, 2007, at age 93. He completed his life's journey at home, surrounded by those he loved.

Stuart was preceded in death by his parents, Christopher and Cora Bergman, his first wife, Ida Bolieu Bergman mother of Bernice Kendrick and Stuart Jr., his sister, Melvina Corbet, his brother, Christopher O. Bergman, and daughter-in-law, Nancy Middleton Bergman.
