Hercules was a student at Zachary Middle School, he was a good student, many people admired him for his ambition, and as an outstanding boxer. He began boxing in July 2002 at the early age of 10 he was a natural in the ring from the start. He boxed for two local gyms, San Fernando Gym and Zarzamora Gym. He was coached by Alfonso Cavazos who knew he'd be a champion boxer. Hercules aspired to be a professional boxer to take care of his Mother so she'd never have to work again. In December 2003 he boxed in the State Silver Glove Championships and won the 10 - 11 Junior division at 95 pounds. January 2004 in North Little Rock, Arkansas at the Regional Silver Glove Championships he won the 10-11 year old Junior division at 95 pounds. February 2004 in Lenexa, Kansas at the National Silver Gloves Championships he took runner-up in his division. On April 21, 2005 at the Regional Texas Junior Olympics tournament in Mission, TX he was Regional State Champion in the 13-14 division at 119 pounds. He was being groomed for the 2008 Olympics. He was full of life and enjoyed basketball, going to the movies and fishing. He was a great son and he will be greatly missed by many. He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Victor and Abelia Menchaca and Miguel Angel Tellez. He is survived by his mother, Ruth Ann Tellez; father, Ted Tellez; step-father, Jesse Joe Maldonado; grandmother, Ruth B. Tellez; sisters, Misty Tellez, Monica
