Teodoro M. Torres, loving father, brother, grandfather, and great-grandfather embraced God on March 28, 2025, in San Antonio, Texas, at the age of 93. Teodoro M. Torres was born March 14, 1932 in Del Rio, Texas.

Teodoro served in the United States Army, 179th Infantry Regt. He fought in the Korean War 1952 – 1953 and upon his honorable discharge, he received the following medals, National Defense Service Medal, Korean Service Medal with Bronze Service Star, Presidential Unit Citation, and a US Army Combat Infantryman Badge.

Upon his return, Teodoro worked as a cement mason, throughout San Antonio, for 53 years, retiring due to doctors' orders. He continued to work as a Security Guard, retiring from the work force in 2016.
