



## Teresa S. Cerna

March 20, 1929 - March 9, 2021

Teresa S. Cerna, age 91, of San Antonio, Texas entered eternal rest on March 9, 2021. She was born on March 20, 1929 in San Marcos, Texas to Guadalupe and Gabriela H. Saucedo. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 57 years, Jesse B. Cerna, her parents, three brothers; Juan Saucedo, Pedro Saucedo, Guadalupe Saucedo, Jr., and one sister; Valentina Pena.

Teresa was employed as a certified nurse's assistant and worked at Normandy Terrace and Babcock North Nursing Homes for approximately 25 years.
