Teresa Estopier was born Teresa Sanchez Alvarado to parents Jose and Francisca Sanchez on April 22nd, 1943, in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico. She peacefully passed on to join our Lord on October 8, 2025.

Teresa married Aurelio Estopier and they were together for 14 cherished years before his passing. Together they had 5 children whom they loved dearly. She raised them all on her own after becoming a widow at the young age of 32. Throughout her life, Teresa worked diligently at various jobs, and ultimately worked as a Licensed Vocational Nurse at a nursing home before retirement.

Teresa was a devout Catholic. Her faith was the foundation of her life and guided her. She prayed the rosary three times a day in her mother's footsteps, and seldom missed Sunday mass even during her travels. She was an adventurer from a very young age. A story is told that at age 12, she was dared to drive a big rig, and did so to everyone's surprise. At 14, she traveled abroad with a family friend and extended her visit for almost a year. For her 15th birthday, she did not want a quinceañera and instead asked for a car. Her siblings recall she required a pillow in order to reach the peddles when driving them around. She was the oldest of 7.

Everyone remembers her cooking. She was an excellent and passionate

cook. She expressed love through food. Teresa was a devoted mother and grandmother. She helped raise all her grandkids, and great grandkids. She would light up a room with the stories of her grandkids. She had a sense of humor. sharing laughter with everyone she met and making others smile with her quick wit and warmth. She loved a good game of Loteria with family and friends, often after Sunday mass.

Teresa is preceded in death by her parents, Jose and Francisca Sanchez; her beloved husband, Aurelio Estopier; and her sister, Aurora Sanchez.

She is survived by her daughters, Mirna Estopier, Edna Estopier, and Denys Estopier; sons, Aurelio Estopier and Ivico Estopier; sisters, Elvira Sanchez and Sylvia Sanchez; brothers, Jose Sanchez, Jesus Sanchez, and Enrique Sanchez, 18 grandchildren, 13 great-grandchildren and a multitude of nieces and nephews who loved her dearly.
