



Theodore Franklin Botkin

May 6, 1935 - November 14, 2005

Theodore Franklin Botkin passed away November 14, 2005 at the age of 70. Dr. Ted, as he was known by many of his friends and patients, was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on May 6, 1935 to Zedric and Penelope Botkin, who preceded him in death. He moved to San Antonio to start a family practice, in which he was active until a week before his passing. His real passion was for medicine and his patients. Dr. Ted was an active member of the Bexar County Medical Society, Texas Medical Association and was Chief of Staff at Southeast Baptist Hospital in 1988. As a tribute to his passion, he has treated many generations of family members, who loved and adored him. Dr. Ted was a lifetime member of the American Paint Horse Association, the San Antonio Livestock Association, and the Bexar County Sheriff's Mounted Posse. His wife, Sonja Botkin, of seventeen years, preceded him in death. He is survived by his former wife, Nola Botkin; his children, Robert, Bradley and Sonita; grandchildren, Alexandria and Kristen; brothers, Ron, Joe and David and sister, Barbara.
