



Thomas Guy Caldwell

May 4, 1932 - March 1, 2015

Thomas Guy Caldwell, 82, a native Texan, died Sunday March 1, 2015 in Lakehills, Texas.

He was born May 4, 1932. He was one of the eleven children of Guy Caldwell and Jeanne Michon Caldwell.

In 1952, he joined the U.S. Navy, where he was an Airplane Electrician for 4 years. After serving in the Navy, Tom was a Master Electrician and a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers IBEW for 62 years and taught at MacArthur High School and all levels of apprenticeship at JATC. He was also an Electrician at the Pearl Brewery.

Mr. Caldwell was a kind-hearted, modest man who loved his family dearly and had a passion for animals and loved many pets over his life.
