



Thomas Gregory "Greg" Gee

February 18, 1958 - March 1, 2017

Greg Gee passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 1, 2017 at the age of 59 after a long hard fought battle against cancer. He was born in Rogers, Arkansas to William Andrew Gee, Sr. and Mary Margaret Corley Gee.

He is preceded in death by his father Bill Gee. He is survived by his mother, Mary Margaret Gee, his Brothers Andy(Cindy) Gee, Steve Gee and sister Karen(Tony) Ianno as well as nephews Coby(Blair) Gee, Shane Gee and fiancée Randyl Cooley, Sean Ianno, Josh Ianno, Nick Ianno and niece Chelsea Ianno.

Greg was an accomplished athlete. He played basketball and golf but truly excelled in baseball at Marshall High School. During his senior year in high school they won Marshall's first outright district title in 16 years. He was an excellent hitter, played 1st base and was an outstanding pitcher with a 5-1 record. He continued his baseball prowess on the softball field after high school and was known for his tremendous arm.

After graduating from Marshall High School, San Antonio in 1976 he went on to own several of his own businesses in painting, moving and landscaping. Over the years he enjoyed coast fishing with his dad and brothers, playing golf, and going on gambling trips. Later in life he perfected his golf game and also became an accomplished black jack player, even making it a career for

about 3 years.

After spending many years working and living in other states he finally decided to call Lake LBJ his home. For the last 4 years he has been living at Lake LBJ with the honorary title of Mayor of Long Mountain Road. He earned that title by being the kind of neighbor everyone would love to have and took care of their property when they were away. Although he did gain some really close human friends at the lake, he was especially partial to the animals including ducks, horses, cats, and in particular Jack the dog.
