Thomas Owens Moore was born October 10, 1926 to Clarence Gordon Moore and Bertha Dorothy Spahr Moore, in San Antonio, Texas. He died March 1, 2014 at the age of 87. Tom enlisted in the US Navy, after having his mother sign for him, on March 1, 1944. He served on the USS Latimer in the South Pacific from August 27, 1944 until October 28, 1945. He then served on the USS Gillette off the coast of California until his discharge on May 21, 1946. Tom married Bernice H.A. Seale February 3, 1951, and they had 63 happy years together. After working in sheet metal construction for a number of years, he became a training coordinator for the sheetmetal workers union and retired from that position. Being a man of many interests, Tom was a member of the Toastmasters and the American Legion. He was a Master Mason in the Grand Lodge of Texas and a member of Alzafar Shriners of San Antonio. A man of great faith, Tom practiced that faith as a member of Western Hills Christian Church, where he was much admired and respected. He was preceded in death by his parents and a half brother Donald "Duck" Moore.
