Timothy Scott Weber was born February 28, 1950 and passed on February 23, 2025 in Fort Worth, Texas, at the age of 74.

Tim's greatest pride was his grandchildren. He attended games, competitions, recognitions, with joy and enthusiasm. He was always available to carpool, babysit, and shuttle them here and there.
