



## Tomás A. Ruiz

July 10, 1945 - June 20, 2025

Tomás A. Ruiz went to be with the Lord on June 20, 2025, in San Antonio, Texas at the age of 79. Tomás was born in Valle Hermoso, Tamaulipas, Mexico on July 10, 1945, to Tomás Ruiz and Crescencia Alvarez Ruiz. He was the oldest of 8 siblings. He attended school through the 6th grade. He worked on the family farm.

He moved to the United States as an undocumented immigrant at the age of 27. He married his wife, Ninfa P. Ruiz, of 51 years on December 24, 1971. Shortly thereafter, he became a U.S. Resident. He retired from City Public Service in 2002 after working there for 30 years as a Pipeman. He became a U.S. citizen in 2007.

Since his retirement, he enjoyed being in his cuartito (shed) listening to his corridos, attending the senior center, his dog, and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his son Tomás Ruiz III; daughters Delia Ruiz, Norma Ruiz (Luis Enriquez), Griselda Ruiz (Eliazar Castillo), and Dora Ruiz (Armando Zuniga); sisters Virginia Zuniga and Alicia Almendarez; brother Luis Ruiz. He is also survived by grandchildren Dylan Tomás Granato, Carlos M. Castro (Julissa Hernandez), Azucena Cervantes, Pablo E. Castro, Sarah E. Castro, and Jesus Cervantes; great grandchildren Lorenzo A. Castro and Alan E.
