He is a Grammy Award winner with many other awards for his craft. Toby Torres has played all around Texas, parts of the United States and Europe.

He is survived by his wife Mary Torres, who loved and cared for him, and his children; Rose Suarez (Florentino Jr.) Toby Jr. Torres (Evelyn), Connie Espinoza (Mike), Jesse Torres (Maria), and Michael Torres with 8 grandchildren, 7 great-grandchildren and numerous extended family members and friends.
