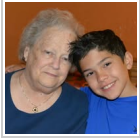

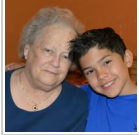
Gay, Thanks so much for everything! You were loved! You will be missed! We will miss your laugh so much!

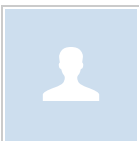
