



Vernon G Baumann

September 15, 1937 - July 10, 2021

Vernon Goetz Baumann, born on September 15, 1937 in San Antonio, Texas, passed peacefully after his valiant battle with Alzheimer's on July 10, 2021 in Helotes, Texas at the age of 83. He is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, Peggy Ann Baumann; his brothers, Walter Baumann and Eddie Baumann; their children, Jack Baumann (wife Candy), Todd Baumann and Audra Baumann Lorentz (husband Kent); and grandchildren, Brandon Baumann, Chance Baumann, Scott Baumann, Mason Gillespie, Caden Gillespie, Kate Baumann and Brooke Baumann.

He was preceded in death by his parents, George Baumann and Hertha Habermann Baumann; brother Joey Baumann; and nephews Randy Baumann and Walter (Walt) Baumann.

Vernon graduated from Little Flower School in 1955 and served in the Army National Guard during the years 1954 through 1963 as an Aircraft Repairman, Motor Sergeant and Section Chief. Vernon was the third of four Baumann brothers, who helped nurture the family business (Baumann Auto Repair) into one of the most reputable automotive repair shops in San Antonio, Texas for well over fifty years - spanning three consecutive generations of Baumann family involvement - from his father to his brothers Joey, Wally, Vernon, and Eddie, and continuing the tradition to this day through Vernon's sons, Jack and Todd. In 1977, Vernon opened Baumann Tune Up Service and upon his

retirement in 2008, his shop was then acquired by Baumann Auto Repair to continue on with his legacy.
