Veronica, beloved mother, grandmother, sister, tía, madrina, second mother and friend, went to be with the Lord at the age of 66 on Wednesday, November 13. She grew up on Jean Street, where she forged lasting memories with her siblings, cousins, and life-long friends. As an advocate and educator in the community, she influenced the lives of many parents, at-risk youth, and victims of domestic violence. Veronica was a woman of faith, who regularly texted morning prayers to her children, grandchildren, other family, and friends. She was an active member at Santa Fe Episcopal Church, where she was a member of the Daughters of the King, worked as a Bishops Warden, and participated wherever she could help with fundraising and administrative work. She adored her children and grandchildren – they are a tight knit group for which she was a shepherd and wonderful example of love, hope, forgiveness, and acceptance.

She was preceded in death by her parents Adolfo Rodriguez, Sr. and Leonarda Vasquez Jimenez.
