Victor R. Almaraz, age 84, entered into eternal rest on Saturday, December 5, 2020, after a courageous battle with liver cancer. He was surrounded by his wife of 50 years and his children. Born in San Antonio, Texas, “Duke” was a proud graduate of Fox Tech and was the San Antonio Golden Gloves Featherweight Champion of 1954. He was a Letter Carrier for the USPS and retired after 36 years of dedicated service. You could always find him watching old westerns or enjoying the outdoors, which often included fishing, hunting and neighborhood watching.

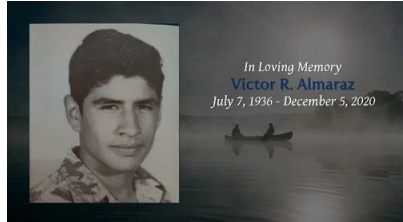
