



## Victor Manuel Hernandez

August 13, 1949 - November 6, 2024

Victor Manuel Hernandez passed peacefully in his home surrounded by family on November 6th, 2024. He was born to Juan Manuel Hernandez and Bisabel Amalia Guajardo Hernandez on August 13th, 1949, in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico. At the young age of 4, he migrated to the United States with his family. At 14 years old, his father passed unexpectedly, and as a result, he left school to help support his mother and younger sister. When he was 18, he was drafted into the military and served from 1969 to 1985. His time in the military included a tour in Vietnam during the Vietnam War, during which he served in the 3rd Platoon, B Company, 8th Squadron, and 1st Air Cavalry. He sustained injuries while overseas, earning him a Purple Heart, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Combat Infantryman's Badge, Vietnam Campaign Medal, and an Army Commendation Medal. He later joined the Army Reserve and then moved to the Air force Reserve, where he worked as an Aircraft scheduler at Kelly Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas. He married his wife of 48 years, Henrietta Hernandez, on February 17th, 1976, and they had 4 children. He is remembered for his witty humor, love of comic books, Elvis Presley, fishing, his favorite baseball team, the LA Dodgers, and his all-time favorite NFL team, the Dallas Cowboys. He is preceded in death by his daughter, Tiffany; his sister, Gloria Woods; and his brother, Benny Hernandez. He is survived by his wife, Henrietta Hernandez; his sisters, Maria M. Valdez, Maria C. Valdez, and Carmen Peyer; his living children, Veronica Hernandez, Jennifer and Paul Ibarra, and Victor Jr and Viviana Hernandez;

his grandchildren, Darius and Alexandra Stewart, Brendan Brown, Mason Brown, Julianne Hernandez, Mikayla Acosta, Zaiden Oldham, Jace Ibarra, Ajani Ibarra, Victoria Hernandez, Victor Hernandez III, Damien Hernandez, and Jasmine Hernandez; and soon to be great-grandchild, Magnolia Stewart.
