



## Victoria Ortiz Garza

February 14, 1921 - June 14, 2013

Victoria Ortiz Garza fell asleep in the Lord on June 14, 2013. She was born on February 14, 1921 in Uvalde, TX to Arturo and Cruz Ortiz. She graduated from Uvalde high school in 1941 and attended Howard Payne University for two years where she met her future husband, Eulogio L. Garza.
