She was immensely proud of her work-life family and was steadfast and dedicated to each over her 50+ years of work.

The family would like to recognize Victoria's lifelong friends and partners in crime, Yolanda, Aunt Dolores, and Aunt Natalia. Yolanda and Victoria worked together for over 35 years, contemplated, and discussed life's challenges, and prayed together for over 50 years.
