MSG "Vince" J.F. Skeebe, U.S. Army Ret., born 15 May 1938 in Hazleton, PA. He was preceded in death by his parents, Vincent and Verna Markovic Skeebe; his 1st wife, Marylou; his 2nd wife, Kiyomi; a sister, Jean Smith. Survived by wife, Aseneth Rubio "AR"; son, Daniel; daughter, Arisa and her husband, Steve Hibdon of San Antonio, TX; sister, Dorothy Domday of Hazleton, PA and numerous nieces and nephews and his baby "Missy". Vince retired from the U.S. Army 31 August 1982 in Anchorage, Alaska after 30 years military service. He worked for Alaska Explosives and Civil Service, also worked for the Alaska Food Bank. In 1986 he met and married Aseneth Rubio and moved her to the wilds of Alaska where they lived for 12 years before returning to San Antonio. During his military career he was awarded many medals and honors, to include the Silver Star, Bronze Star with V, C.I.B., commendation medal, master parachute badge, plus numerous campaign medals. He served several tours in Vietnam with the Special Forces. Viewing will be at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Tuesday, December 15, 2009. The Graveside Service will begin at 10:30 AM on Wednesday, December 16, 2009 at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery with military honors. Pallbearers will be members of Special Forces Chapter XV.
