Vince Everett, born in Taylorville, Illinois, on June 8, 1969, entered eternal rest on September 16, 2025. He was welcomed into heaven with open arms by his loving mother, Gwendolyn “Gindy” Everett; his father, Delmar Everett; and his father-in-law, Steven Quintero.

From an early age, Vince carried a deep sense of service and purpose, enlisting in the U.S. Army before he turned 18. With his quick wit, Vince had a

remarkable ability to make people laugh—even in life’s hardest moments—leaving a lasting impression on colleagues, family, and friends alike.

Outside of work, Vince embraced every moment life had to offer. He was a passionate sports fan, watching his beloved St. Louis Cardinals, collecting baseball cards, and cheering on his Washington Redskins on Sunday afternoons at home with a Pepsi and good snacks. A true auto enthusiast, he loved attending meet-ups and shows, proudly showcasing his prized 1967 Chevy Nova and iconic 1997 Toyota Supra.
