Virginia Lee (Farris) Brigman, age 88, of Converse, TX passed away due to a cardiac arrest on July 4, 2020 at the San Antonio Wellness and Rehabilitation facility.

Virginia was born on April 6, 1932 in the Township of Fairmount, Leavenworth County, KS. She grew up in Basehor, KS and graduated from Basehor High School in 1950. She married Ralph Brigman in the First Baptist Church of Basehor, September 23, 1951. After farming for many years in Basehor, the family moved to Monroe, WA in 1969.
