Virginia Wilson Evers, daughter, wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, friend, legal secretary, bookkeeper, volunteer, gardener, accordion player, craftmaker, and avid social networker, both face to face and online, went home to meet her Lord on June 29, 2016.
