



Virginia "Gigi" Mattke Duke

October 10, 1935 - October 26, 2021

Virginia "Gigi" Mattke Duke passed away peacefully at the age of 86 on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 in Keller, Texas.

Born on October 10, 1935 in San Antonio, Texas to Fred and Helen Mattke, Gigi attended Benjamin Franklin Elementary School and graduated from Thomas Edison High School in 1953. Throughout her life, Gigi was surrounded and beloved by parents, sisters, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, life-long friends, her daughters and their families.

Gigi was committed to faith, family, community, career, education, adventure, and making sure her girls NEVER embarrassed her!

She loved her Lord and her church, First Presbyterian Church. She was from the generation that believed in bringing the best version of yourself to church. She loved presenting her classy self to worship in the house of her Lord with her church family.

Gigi was dedicated to her family and her family was dedicated to her. She loved Churchill High School football more than anyone. Along with her little sister, Helen and her brother-in-law Lamar, she was in the stands at every game that her girls danced at, cheered at, or marched at. When she wasn't at a game, she was at a horse show, piano recital, choir concert, dance, drill or cheer competition. In between all that activity, Gigi was sewing costumes, uniforms, prom dresses, and school clothes. The most important lesson she taught her girls was the use of starch when ironing because, "MY girls will never leave the house in wrinkled clothes!"

Gigi loved her community, particularly her Grey Forest community. She loved going to council meetings, playing bunco, going to exercise class, volunteering at Christian Assistance Ministry (CAM), and recording the oral histories of veterans at the Nimitz Museum. There was never a time when she wasn't planning a high school, airline or cousins' reunion and she did it without a computer!

Gigi was committed to work and education. She was employed by Braniff Airways, American Airlines, and Sun Country Airlines for over forty years. She instilled in her girls a strong work ethic, a love of travel, and the education that goes with traveling. There was never a time that she wasn't researching a country and planning her next trip. She was determined that she and her girls would see the world and get an education.

Gigi had it all...brains, beauty, class and a sense of adventure that took her to over forty countries during her lifetime. As an airline employee, she took full advantage of the perks even if it meant the whole family didn't make the same flight. Gigi would often stick one or two of her girls on a flight, and say, "We'll just meet you there." "There" could have been Dallas or Europe and her girls just trusted her – even as young as 10! Braniff employees from San Antonio to Austria knew to look out for "Gigi's girls." Mom was one of a kind!

She was preceded in death by her parents and half-brother, Fred Mattke, Jr. She is survived by her daughters, Karen Lively and her husband, Ernie, Yana Gordon and Kellie Henderson; grandchildren, Jennifer Cleveland and husband, Mick, John Lively, Carrie Lively, Grant Gordon and his fiancéé, Emma Ritter, Emily Gordon and Carson Henderson; great granddaughter, Elizabeth Cleveland; her sisters, Carolyn Vance and Helen Pfeiffer and her husband, Lamar; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and their families.
