Virginia B. Gutierrez, 73, passed away on Wednesday, January 9, 2019. She was born to the late John and Carmen Barbosa on March 31, 1945, in San Antonio, Texas.

As soon as her children got married and had children of their own, she began

caring for her grandchildren. She was very reliable for good, wholesome, love and attention for her family.

All her life, she would teach her family the importance of having God in their lives and was a living example of how a godly person should conduct his or her life. This was very obvious when her son John brought home a pastor from his church one day, who eventually led his parents to the Lord and they became born again. Praise God!

She began attending University Baptist Church where, again, she was active in child care, food and meal preparation, and bible study. She enjoyed studying the bible and helping others learn it as well.

Despite her failing health, Virginia was a tough cookie! She was able to enjoy her last year at an assisted living facility, where she made new friends, started craft activities, and helped others. She loved people and was always watching out for those who couldn't defend themselves. She felt like they need to be heard, so she was their voice. Unfortunately, her complicated medical issues overtook her and caused her death.
