She definitely had a green thumb and could bring anything back to life. Virginia loved her cats so much she made a cat room for them. She would bring home any injured cat to nurture them back to health or they would just show up at her door. God must have known she loved animals. She loved wildlife: Elephants, Zebras, and Giraffes. Virginia loved western movies, most foods especially her pies and cakes & could make the best lemon meringue & coconut pies. On a sweet note, her favorite Gospel song was Because He Lives, How Great Thou Art, & The Old Rugged Cross.
