



Virginia A. Slimp

On July 15, 2015, Ms. Virginia Lockhart Slimp passed from this life. A Daughter of the Republic of Texas, Baylor Graduate with two Masters Degrees, and a devoted member of Trinity Baptist Church, Virginia lived a life of learning, spirituality, and fellowship. Born in San Antonio in 1930, she graduated early from Brackenridge School and Baylor University, then sought to further America's appreciation of the works of Jesse Stuart through her first Master's thesis. At Indiana University, she worked in the laboratory of geneticist and Nobel laureate, Dr. Herman Muller. An accomplished vocalist, she sang in church choirs wherever education and jobs lead, often accompanied by her first husband, John Jeter. She married Chester Slimp II and moved to Castle Hills where her third child was born and continued her devotion to volunteer church work. Her final church home was at Trinity Baptist. She is preceded in death by parents, Paul and Lessie and Brother Paul. She leaves behind children Andrew Slimp II, Suzanne Jeter, John David Jeter, Jr., Brother Robert, Sister Martha, and seven grandchildren. We will miss her.
